




## PANORAMED's Approach

- PANORAMED is a pioneering approach aiming to better governance in the Mediterranean, both at national and regional level and promoting innovative cooperation frameworks in the Mediterranean.
- It constitutes an innovative Governance Platform which together with six Strategic Projects completes the Axis 4 centered in Governance of the EU's Interreg Mediterranean Programme 2014-2020 programming period .
- It completes a structure as the top governance component with a lower layer on modular projects and another with horizontal projects and the corresponding thematic communities
- The project's main goal is to foster mutual knowledge and cooperation between the main stakeholders of the Mediterranean area, mobilising their knowledge and experience for shared governance of this territory.



## Challenges and Goals

**Aim & main challenge** = to establish and develop a multilateral *coordination* framework in the Mediterranean for joint responses to common challenges

### Specific goals of the Governance framework:

1. Enhancement and reinforcement of institutional capacity of public authorities
2. Contribution to coordinated synergies and dynamics
3. Contribution to reinforced cooperation with the South shore of the Mediterranean



# PANORAMED Working Architecture



## How does PANORAMED work? (I)

Structured and integrated framework linking systematically projects' results to policy and actors.



Ensure sustainability of projects and results, promote dialogue and consensus building in Mediterranean issues.

### WORKING PATH

1. Set up of **common methodology** for **Thematic Working Groups** (TWG) to use, benchmark and liaise data produced by MED projects from 2007-2013 and 2014-2020.
2. Initial **bottom-up** to **collect results** produced by the MED projects and by other Mediterranean programmes / initiatives on identified thematic sectors.
3. **GGOR** allowing to identify strengths and weaknesses and providing the basis for the elaboration of **Strategic Projects' Terms of Reference**.

## Main governance milestones

- **Key Policy Papers (KPP)** in each Strategic Theme
  - Coastal and Maritime Tourism, Maritime Surveillance, Innovation
- **Panoramed Stocktaking Paper** presented at the MED annual event, Paris November 11, 2020
  - The way forward: better governance for a Mediterranean Green Deal*
- **PANORAMED Dialogues event** held in November 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021 and brief presented in January 2022
- **MED Positioning Paper** presented in March 2022
  - Better governance as a specific objective for Interreg and transnational territorial cooperation*

## 6 Strategic Projects

### SPs on Coastal and Maritime Tourism

1. **BESTMED** - overcoming seasonality and the lack of effective cooperation among tourism actors;
2. **SMARTMED** - empowering the Mediterranean for SMART Tourism.

### SPs on Maritime Surveillance

1. **SHAREMED** – sharing and enhancing capabilities to address environmental threats in Mediterranean Sea;
2. **MEDOSMOSIS** – Mediterranean governance for Strategic Maritime Surveillance and Safety issues.

### SPs on Innovation

1. **B-BLUE** – creating the blue biotechnology community, connecting research and business;
2. **BLUEBIOMED** – building and sharing a common knowledge on the blue bioeconomy.
